

Safe Entry into Port Guichon

Morning arrival – We ask all students to line-up at the designated areas (out their classrooms/pods). If students are dropped off at the new round-about, please ask your child to go around the outside of the school to their designated areas. Your cooperation will reinforce the expectations held at the school and at the same time reassure all students that fair practice is being honoured.

Our morning supervision begins at 8:30. **Students should not arrive at school before 8:30** unless special arrangements have been made with their teacher.

Parents/Visitors – We ask all parents and visitors to sign in at the office and pick up a Visitor Badge. In this way we can help ensure that our school remains a safe place. Thank you for your cooperation.

Students Going Home for Lunch

To ensure the supervision and safety of your children during the lunch hour, both the home and school need a schedule which each child is to follow. Students will be permitted to leave the school grounds during our lunch hour (or any time after arrival) **ONLY** with your written consent. If your child goes home during the lunch hour, please complete, detach and return to school the permission slip attached to the last page of this newsletter.

Student Absences

Please contact the school when your child is absent from school. You can contact the school by calling the office at 604-946-0321. Our answering machine is available 24 hours a day, so you can call the night before if you know your child will be away. You can also email Linda Ward at lward@deltasd.bc.ca. Failure to notify the school will prompt a phone call home to ensure that each child is accounted for each morning.

When to Keep Your Sick Child Home

For the protection of your child, as well as other children, keep your child home if he/she:



- Has a fever
- Is too sick to take part in all normal school activities
- Has a suspected or known communicable disease (i.e. strep throat, pink eye, chicken pox, or any other undiagnosed rash).


Keep them home until they are no longer infectious.

Please let the school know your child's symptoms.

TRAFFIC AND PARKING!

The first roundabout is intended to serve as a "drop and go" and "quick pick-up" area. Under no circumstances should cars park in the roundabout. There is room for 8 cars at a time to pull off to the RIGHT hand side of the structure and have children (dis)embark through the right hand side of their vehicles. Drivers can then pull out into the left—hand lane to carry on and exit (see diagram for more information). Please be particularly aware of driveway traffic and pedestrians walking down the sidewalk along our parking lot when entering and exiting this new traffic structure. Please also remember that the roundabout nearest to the school is intended for use by our school buses and other authorized vehicles. Please do not use it for student drop off, pick-up, or parking.

Please remind your children not to run across the new roundabout, grass circle or driveway areas. Buses and trucks are often backing up and may not see little ones dashing into the roadway.



^{**}Please be very careful if you park along the south side of the parking lot, as this makes it difficult for cars to get in and out of the designated parking stalls. Thank you.

STUDENTS GOING HOME FOR LUNCH 2019/2020

Dear Parents/Guardians:To ensure the supervision and safety of your children during the lunch hour, both the home and school need a schedule which each child is to follow. Students will be permitted to leave the school grounds at noon (or any time after arrival) **ONLY** with your written consent. What your child does off the school grounds at noon hour is a common concern and perhaps you might take some time to discuss this with your family.

We must know that children leaving the school grounds during the school day do so with your knowledge and consent as to where, when, and why they do so. We suggest that you do not give your child permission to leave except for the purpose of having lunch.

We do encourage you to have your children come home for lunch for the following reasons:

- the break in the students' routine is refreshing and energizing
- it provides an opportunity for more adult and individual contact

Remember – The lunch break is not a full hour. Break begins at 12:10 PM.

First bell is at 12:57 PM and second bell is at 1:02 PM.
