HEALTH PROTOCOLS

WHEN TO KEEP YOUR CHILD AT HOME

- Everyone entering the school needs to make sure that they are healthy. Anyone who is feeling sick needs to self-isolate at home so they don't get others sick.
- Parents and caregivers must assess their child's health daily – refer to the attached Daily Health Check.
- If you are unsure about sending your child to school, please refer to the BC COVID-19 Self-Assessment Tool, or contact 811, or the local public health unit to seek further input.
- If your child does become sick while at school, they will be isolated and you will be notified and asked to pick up your child **as soon as possible**.

PREPARING YOUR CHILD FOR A DAY AT SCHOOL

- Please ensure that your child washes his/her hands before school and when they return home. This will be a routine procedure throughout your child's day at school.
- Your child will be asked to use only their personal items and not to share them.
- During the summer months, please apply sunscreen to your child before they arrive at school, or send sunscreen they are able to apply themselves (teachers will not be permitted to apply sunscreen to your child), and a hat for sunny days, and proper clothing for all kinds of weather, as may be spending lots of time outdoors.

MORNING DROP OFF/PICK UP

- Students will go to their class line up area to wait social distancing themselves from other students.
- Parents will not be able to come into the school, unless absolutely necessary. This would be through the office only.

ENTERING THE BUILDING

- Students will be invited in from the line up one by one and must be able to enter the school independently. Students upon entering will first take time to wash their hands
- Each student will go to their desk in the classroom and wait there until all the students arrive (activity to do while waiting)

CLASSROOM SET UP - The Classroom will look different

- Students jackets and everything they need will be brought in and kept at their workspace.
- Desks/tables/spaces will be set up to leave at least space in between them
- Many things in the classroom have been put away
- Students will sit at their own table or desk

LOTS AND LOTS OF HAND WASHING

- There will be many hand washing times throughout the day
- It is highly recommended that students bring their own personal, unscented hand sanitizer with greater than 60% ethanol or 70% isopropanol as active ingredients.

WASHROOM USE

- We will limit washroom use to one at a time
- We need to limit the things that we touch and keep them clean
- Washrooms are assigned to Classrooms

Masks

- Mask wearing is Mandatory

SNACKS AND LUNCHES

- Children should bring all food in a lunch bag and containers that can be packed in and all remaining food and wrappers will be packed out (you may want to send an extra baggie to pack the garbage in)
- There will be NO lunch drop off after school start
- Students will eat snacks and lunch in their assigned seat
- Students will eat only their own food, and will not share with others.

THE CUSTODIANS WILL WORK HARD TO HELP KEEP OUR SCHOOL CLEAN

- We need to remember to respect how to use all areas of our school
- We can make their job easier by making sure that we clean up after ourselves and leave our desk/table spaces clear.
- Our school will be cleaned more frequently, including classrooms and high touch areas.

ATTENDANCE

- If your child is unable to attend school on a day they have been scheduled to attend, please call the school office to notify them.

There may be more classroom instructions coming from your teacher.
